Members receive our quarterly journal, in which articles, interests, letters and queries are among the items included. Contributions to the Journal are submitted by members and the Journal is particularly useful to our distant and overseas members whose queries and correspondence are always welcome. The society has published several indexes to various records in the N.F.H.S. Records Series. Surname indexes to the 1841-1901 censuses for Notts. are already available. Baptism and burial registers across the county are being transcribed and a database is available of the current transcriptions. Marriages for the whole county for the period 1813-1837 are published. Indexes for the Phillimore volumes are available on microfiche and the marriages not included in the Phillimore volumes have been indexed and published. There are also several volumes of Monumental Inscriptions which have been recorded by members and currently several cemeteries are in the process of being transcribed. Details of all our publications available for purchase are published periodically in the Journal and are on our website.
